## Goals

The ongoing goal at Cantalician Center is to provide comprehensive and family centered evaluations of children who are suspected of having learning difficulties, speech and language delays, sensory motor disorders, behavior problems or motor delays.

## Types of Evaluations

- Multidisciplinary initial evaluation for school district Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE).
- Multidisciplinary Developmental Evaluations (MDEs) for early intervention programs.
- Supplemental Early Intervention evaluations (when child is observed to have an additional area of need).

Cantalician Center is available to help families make referrals to their county's Early Intervention Program or to the school district's Committee on Preschool Special Education.

## Multi-disciplinary Evaluation Team

Providing state required components of a preschool evaluation including:

- Speech/Language Pathologist
- Occupational Therapist
- Physical Therapist
- Special Ed. Teacher (including bilingual Spanish)
- School Psychologist

The Evaluation Team offers off site evaluations in homes, within schools, daycare centers, and community organizations across seven counties of Western New York. Evaluations may also be completed in our Early Childhood Center in Depew, New York.
