

What are Supported Employment Services?

Finding the job that matches interests and abilities, and provides supports to help achieve stability. Once a desirable job match is identified, the Job Coach will provide training to help the individual become oriented to the work routine and environment. The Supported Employment program will continue to provide whatever supports are necessary to help the individual achieve a successful employment outcome.

Services Offered

- Community Based Worksite Assessments (CBWA) and Diagnostic Vocational Evaluations (DVE).
- Individualized Job Development and Job Placement services.
- Mobility training to ensure the individual can safely and consistently travel to and from the placement of employment.
- Intensive, individualized on-site Job Training.
- Supportive Extended Services to ensure long-term success on the job.
- On-going services provided to ensure long-term success on the job.
- School Transition Services Designed to help students successfully bridge the gap or move from high school to college or employment.
- ACCES-VR Orientations occur several times each month, the Cantalician Center holds orientation sessions in the community, providing basic information about ACCES-VR services, and helping people with the application process.



The Cantalician Center prioritizes finding the right job match. Staff have helped many people find full-time and part-time work in numerous types of positions including food preparation, customer service, clerical work, health care, security, assembly, production, maintenance, courier services, housekeeping, and many more.
