

CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE: PRESCHOOL UPDATE 10/15/2020

Last night, Cantalician Center was in contact with the Erie County Health Department (ECDOH) and upon learning of one (1) positive COVID-19 case in our Preschool classroom they indicated that the actions of switching the affected classroom to remote learning and preventatively quarantining the students and staff associated with that room was the correct course of action. Our information has been provided to the designated Erie County Contact Tracer for schools in our area, who will be in contact with anyone that has been affected.

Per the guidance from the New York State Education Department, we are currently cleaning and sanitizing the classroom. The ECDOH will notify us when we can resume in-person instruction in that classroom and will we will be in contact with everyone affected. The rest of the school will continue to remain open.

Symptoms of COVID-19 may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. Possible symptoms include:

1. Fever or chills
2. Cough
3. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
4. Fatigue
5. Muscle or body aches
6. Headache
7. New loss of taste or smell
8. Sore throat
9. Congestion or runny nose
10. Nausea or vomiting
11. Diarrhea

If you begin to experience any of the above symptoms, please stay home and call your medical provider.

If you are having any of the following symptoms, you should seek immediate medical attention:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion or inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE: PRESCHOOL 10/14/2020 (6:30 P.M.)

On Wednesday, October 14, 2020, Cantalician Center for Learning was made aware of one (1) confirmed positive COVID-19 case in its Preschool.

Per the guidance from the New York State Education Department, we will be moving the affected classroom to a Remote Learning platform while we clean and sanitize the classroom. The rest of the school will remain open at this time.

All parties that are affected have been contacted. We will be notifying the Erie County Health Department (ECDOH) as soon as it opens at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, October 15, 2020.
