Music Teacher – Preschool and School Age

GENERAL PURPOSE OF POSITION

Provide music education to preschool and/or school age students with developmental disabilities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Development of curriculum, content, materials, and methods of instruction.
- Write specific lesson plans that are creative and demonstrate a variety of instructional methods.
- Engage students in activities that are interesting, meaningful and individualized to reflect students' developmental level.
- Instruction of singing fundamentals, rhythmic movements, and group singing.
- Assessment of students' ability to participate in chorus or instrumental lessons.
- Responsible for the direction of plays, shows, and/or school concerts.
- Select and obtain materials and supplies such as props, musical instruments,
- Help each student to mature academically, emotionally and socially.
- Provide care and instruction to promote a safe environment for students and staff.
- Ensure a clean and orderly work environment.
- Formulate long-term goals and short-term objectives.
- Provide information about each student's progress to appropriate family members and human service professionals via the classroom teacher.
- Ensure that aides and assistants assist with classroom responsibilities as well as during plays or performances.
- At all times assuming responsibility for the management of the class.
- Provide clear and succinct direction to students and staff.
- Utilize Strategies for Crisis Intervention and Prevention (SCIP) procedures in the School Program when necessary.
- Establish and maintain positive communications with family and caregivers.
- Establish an effective data collection and charting system to monitor students' progress.
- Document progress toward goals on the IEP, at specified intervals (e.g., 3 months, 6 months, etc.)
- Maintain a current inventory of CCL equipment and supplies in the classroom. Ensure that
 equipment and supplies are used appropriately. Submit maintenance requests when
 necessary to ensure proper functioning of the room and its contents.
- Keep abreast of developments in field by reading current literature and participating in professional conferences.
- Consistently comply with all agency policies and procedures.
- Constantly maintain high professional standards at work with regard to personal behavior and interactions with other staff and families.
- Perform other duties as requested by the Principal and/or Director of Education.

SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- High level of written and oral communication.
- High level of interpersonal skills.
- High level of behavior management skills.
- High level of knowledge of educational principles, especially those that apply to students with disabilities.
- Possess good time management skills.
- Knowledge of computers to prepare monthly lessons and progress reports and educational materials needed.
- High level of creativity.
- Ability to play at least one instrument, piano or guitar.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND/OR TRAINING

- Bachelor's Degree in Music Education
- Provisional music teacher certification (either from the New York State Educational
 Department or accepted by them.) Permanent certification must be obtained and
 documentation substantiating same provided to the Agency within five years of provisional
 certification, unless a shorter duration is required by law.
- An acceptable background check (includes fingerprinting).
